GYMNASTICS STARS

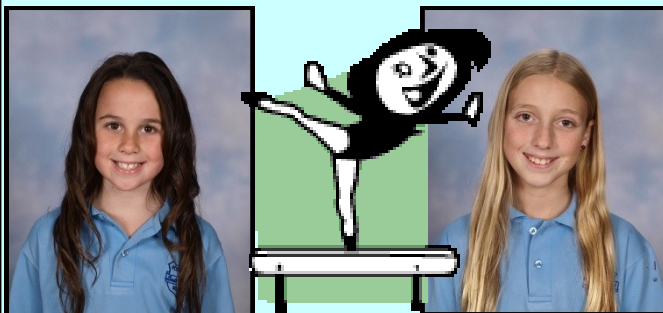

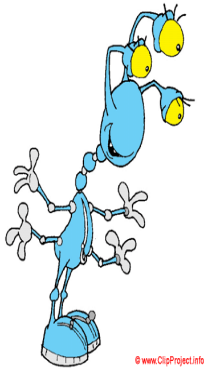


PREMIER'S READING CHALLENGE

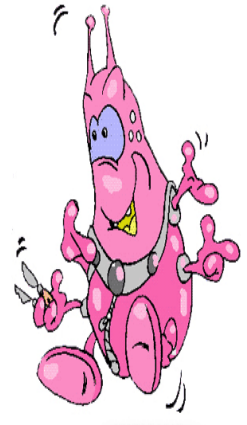

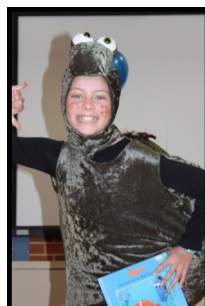
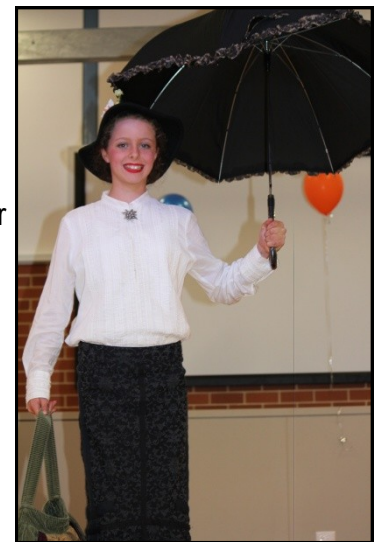
LIBRARY NEWS
