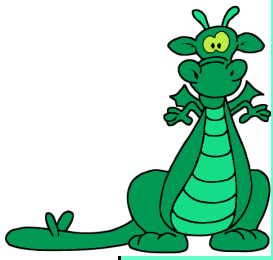

Given that our students are involved in regular physical activity and play throughout the week there are important restrictions on what students can wear to school as jewellery or accessory items.</p> <p>Hats are not to have studs or badges attached to them. As a general rule, no jewellery is allowed. This includes chains, rings, bracelets and necklaces.</p> <p>Stud earrings, sleepers and watches are the only acceptable jewellery. Nail polish and cosmetics should not be worn to school. Small necklaces for religious, cultural or health reasons (this includes medic alert style bracelets as well) are permitted with a note. They are to be worn under the child's clothing. Sunglasses are also allowed to be worn.</p> <p>For safety reasons no other piercings are allowed.</p>
<p>HATS (Lindsay Park Public School has a "no hat, no play" policy). Hats are worn outdoors during all seasons. A royal blue broad brimmed hat (brim 6cm Infants, 8cm Primary) is the uniform.</p>	

HAIR

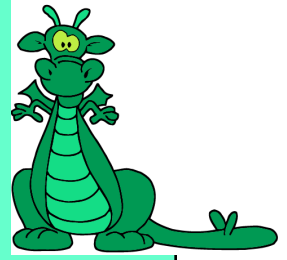
